

Proper for June 16, 2019, Trinity Sunday

Theme: “Walking in Trinitarian Truth”

Apply this Proper to the main Liturgy for the Easter Season, since all white days use that base file.

Acclamation

Presider: Blessed be God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit;  
People: And blessed be His Kingdom, now and forever. *Amen.*

Collect of the Day

Almighty and everlasting God, You have given to us Your servants grace, by the confession of a true faith, to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity, and in the power of Your divine Majesty to worship the Unity: Keep us steadfast in this faith and worship, and bring us at last to see You in Your one and eternal glory, O Father; Who with the Son and the Holy Spirit lives and reigns, one God, forever and ever. Amen.

Old Testament Proclamation: Isaiah 59: 15-21

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 29

New Testament Proclamation: Romans 5: 1-5

Gospel Proclamation: John 16: 5-15

Gradual Verse:

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God.

Prayers of the People:

Deacon: Let us pray for the whole state of Christ’s Church, and for the world.

Minister: Almighty Father, we lift before You Your holy catholic Church:  
People: *That You would lead us in truth, baptize us in love, and unite us in spirit.*

Minister: We pray for her leaders, especially Bishop Craig and Bishop Ariel:  
People: *That they may with one voice minister Your life to Your people and the world.*

Minister: We lift before You the people of this community, this nation, and the world:  
*People: That we may honor one another and serve the common good.*

Minister: We pray for our governmental leaders, especially President Aquino:  
*People: That You would lead them in the ways of justice and peace.*

Minister: We lift before You all who suffer in body, mind, or spirit:  
*People: That You would send Your comfort and grace upon them.*

Minister: We pray especially for those whom we now name before You: \_\_\_\_\_

Minister: Give to the departed eternal rest:  
*People: Grant that we may share with them in Your everlasting Kingdom.*

Deacon: And we lift before You this parish, in the manner in which You have given unto us:  
*People: As we pray our Corporate Petition.*

### The Concluding Collect

Presider: For Your truth, and Your healing, and Your strength, and Your peace endure forever, and You sit as King forever, O You Who was, and Who is, and Who is to come; our Lord God Almighty. To You we lift these prayers, O eternal and Triune God; ***Amen.***

### Proper Preface

Father, all powerful and everliving God, we do well always and everywhere to give You thanks.

We joyfully proclaim our faith in the mystery of the Trinity. You have revealed Your glory as the glory also of Your Son and of the Holy Spirit: three persons equal in majesty, undivided in splendor, yet one Lord, one God, ever to be adored in Your everlasting glory.

And so, with all the choirs of angels in heaven we proclaim Your glory and join their unending hymn of praise:
