People: For all who proclaim the Gospel, and all who seek the Truth.

Minister: For Craig our Patriarch, Ricardo our Primate, and Ariel our Bishop; and for all bishops and other ministers;

People: For all who serve You in Your Church.

Minister: For the special needs and concerns of this congregation:

The people may lift up the names of those in special need.

Minister: Hear us, Lord;

People: For Your mercy is great.

Minister: We thank You, Lord,

People: For all the blessings of this life.

The people may add their own thanksgivings.

Minister: We exalt You, O God our King;

People: And praise Your Name forever and ever.

Minister: We pray for all who have died,

People: That they may have a place in Your eternal Kingdom.

The people may add their own petitions.

Minister: Lord, let Your lovingkindness be upon them;

People: Who put their trust in You.

The Presider may invite the people to offer extemporaneous prayers as the Holy Spirit leads.

After the extemporaneous prayers, the Presider leads the Corporate Petition, as follows:
