Collect of the Day

O God, whose blessed Son made Himself known to His disciples in the breaking of bread:

Open the eyes of our faith, that we may behold Him in all His redeeming work; Who lives and reigns with You, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. *Amen.*

First Reading: Acts 9:1-19

Psalm Reading: Psalm 30

Gradual Verse

Prayers of the People

Form VII (Made from directions in BCP)

Deacon: Let us pray for the whole state of Christ’s Church, and for the world.

Minister: Almighty Father, we lift before You Your holy catholic Church:

People: That You would lead us in truth, baptize us in love, and unite us in spirit.

Minister: We pray for her leaders, especially Bishop Craig, Bishop Ricardo, and Bishop Ariel:

People: That they may with one voice minister Your life to Your people and the world.

Minister: We lift before You the people of this community, this nation, and the world:

People: That we may honor one another and serve the common good.

Minister: We pray for our governmental leaders, especially President Duterte:

People: That You would lead them in the ways of justice and peace.

Minister: We lift before You all who suffer in body, mind, or spirit:

People: *That You would send Your comfort and grace upon them.*

Minister: Give to the departed eternal rest:

People: *Grant that we may share with them in Your everlasting Kingdom.*

The Presider may invite the people to offer extemporaneous prayers as the Holy Spirit leads, followed by the Corporate Petition, as follows:

Presider: Let us lift up to God the Corporate Petition:
